ADOPTION AGREEMENT

I agree to the following for my pet adopted from Kauai Humane Society:

1. To treat the animal in a humane manner at all times.
2. To provide veterinary care when necessary.
3. To maintain a current license for dogs and ID for cats.
4. To abide by State Laws and County Ordinances regarding animals.
5. To not use the animal for vivisection or experiments of any kind, for food purposes, or for pig hunting.
6. To bring the animal to the Kauai Humane Society or find it another suitable home, if I can no longer care for it.
7. I completely and fully release the Kauai Humane Society and its officers, employees, and agents from and against any and all liability arising out of the performance of any of the surgical procedures, and from any liability for any illness of the animal or damage which it may do to any person or property. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Kauai Humane Society for any action, suits, or other claims arising out of my possession of the animal.
8. If I return the animal for any reason, within 30 days, the adoption fee will be refunded. Dog license fees are not refundable.
9. I further understand that the original owner may redeem the animal, if a stray, from me at any time within 30 days after the arrival date to Kauai Humane Society. In return, I will receive from the original owner reimbursement for fees paid and the sum of \$5.00 for each day that the animal has been in my possession. After 30 days, the animal becomes my property.
10. To knowingly and willfully violate the terms and conditions of this agreement is considered a breach of contract, giving the Kauai Humane Society the legal right to reclaim the animal and issue citations for a violation of any animal-related laws.
