HOW MUCH DOES CRITTER CAMP COST?

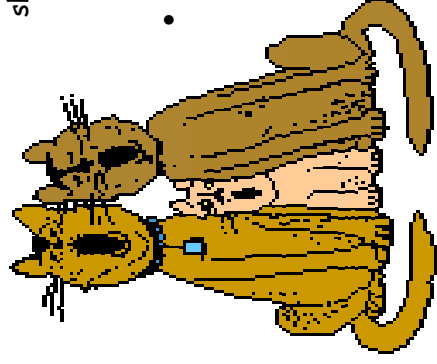
