

EMERGENCY PREPARATION FOR PETS

- Emergency checklist for each pet
- Mobile Home for each pet (carrier, crate, or cage) big enough for them to live in comfortably for up to a week.
 - Collar or harness, I.D. tag, leash, and microchip record
- Photo of each pet with current health record (vaccinations, flea treatment, worming, etc.)
 - Minimum of one week supply of food and special medications
 - Non-spill bowls for food and water
 - Cat litter pan with one week supply of litter
 - Litter scoop, can opener, spoon, etc.
- Unbreakable water storage container with one week supply of water
- Newspapers, plastic bags, cleansers, paper towels, and trash bags
 - Toys, towels, treats and chews

Kauai Humane Society has emergency sheltering available for pets when evacuation is needed due to a disaster. However, we are limited by the number of housing units (kennels, caging) available. Please, secure and store one crate/cage for each pet in your household. The housing unit needs to be big enough for the pet to lie down, turn around, stand up, and sit. For cats, it needs enough room to place a litter box. We also require all pets to be current on their vaccinations for their protection. Please prepare now, don't delay!
